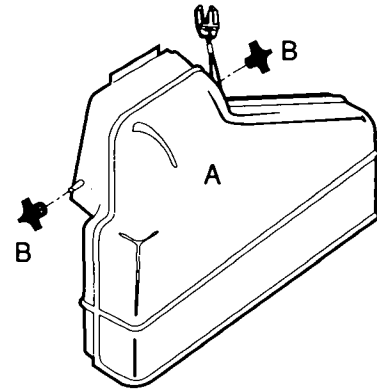

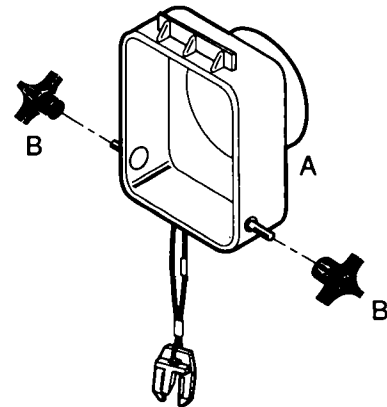

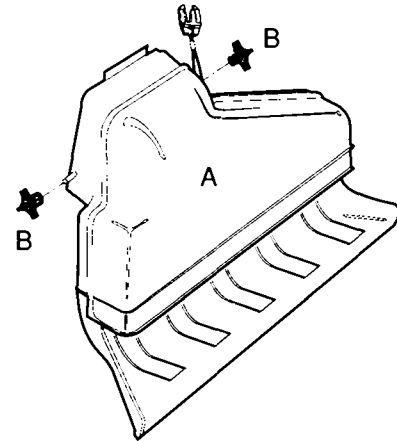

! WARNING

This Troy-Bilt Chipper/Vac is provided with a safety interlock system which prevents the engine from starting unless a vacuuming attachment and the fan cover are installed. It is also designed to shut off the engine if the operator attempts to remove a vacuuming attachment or the fan cover while the engine is running. Never attempt to disconnect or to otherwise defeat the purpose of this system. If the interlock system fails to operate properly, shut off the engine and do not operate the equipment until the system has been repaired and is functioning properly.

Before using the equipment each day, check the operation of the safety interlock system as explained in your Troy-Bilt Chipper/Vac Owner/Operator Manual.

Failure to follow these instructions can result in serious personal injury.

! CAUTION

Before changing vacuuming attachments or screens, or before adjusting fan cover, shut off engine, disconnect spark plug wire from spark plug, and allow all moving parts to come to a complete stop.

Do not operate equipment with vacuum snout unless collection bag is installed.
